$$7 \times y^2 x^{(-4)} (x^{(-2)})^2 x^3 (y^{(-3)})^2$$

$$\frac{5x^{(-8)} \times y^6 (x^4 \times y^4)^4}{1 \times y^{(-1)} (x^{(-2)})^2}$$

$$6 \times y^{(-2)} x^5 (x^4)^6 x^3 (y^4)^{(-2)}$$
